CASE SUMMARY

Claimants asserted causes of action for: breach of fiduciary; negligence; and failure to supervise. The causes of action related to the purchase and sale of various securities.

Respondents denied the allegations of wrongdoing set forth in the Claimants' Statement of Claim and asserted various defenses.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimants requested compensatory damages of \$472,000.00, plus interest, attorney's fees, the costs of this proceeding, and for other such relief deemed just and proper by the Arbitration panel.

Respondents requested dismissal of the Claimants' Statement of Claim in its entirety and that Claimants be assessed forum fees, costs, reasonable attorney's fees and for other such relief deemed just and proper by the Arbitration panel. In addition, Respondents requested that all references to this matter be expunged from Respondent Matthew Johnson's registration records maintained by the NASD Central Registration Depository ("CRD")

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

On or about January 15, 2002, Claimants filed a Motion for Sanctions. On February 13, 2002, the Panel granted Claimants' Motion for Sanctions in part and denied in part. Claimants were awarded \$2,000.00 in sanctions. Respondents, Josephthal & Co., Inc. and Matthew Johnson were ordered to pay the Claimants \$2,000.00 within thirty (30) days from the date of the Panel's Order.

The parties agreed that the Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies or that a handwritten, signed Award may be entered.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, testimony, and evidence presented at the hearing, and the post-hearing submissions (if any), the Panel decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1) Respondents Josephthal & Co., Inc. and Matthew Johnson are jointly and severally liable and shall pay to Claimants compensatory damages in the amount of \$195,000.00 plus eight percent (8%) interest from March 28, 2002 until date of payment. The award is based upon Respondents' breach of fiduciary duty, negligence, and negligent supervision.
- 2) Respondents Josephthal & Co., Inc. and Matthew Johnson are jointly and severally liable, and shall pay to Claimants the sum of \$300.00 representing reimbursement of the claim filing fee previously paid by Claimants to NASD Dispute Resolution, Inc.
- 3) Respondents Josephthal & Co., Inc. and Matthew Johnson shall comply with the Panel's Order on Claimants' Motion for Sanctions.
- 4) Any and all other requests for relief not specifically addressed herein, including Claimants request for attorney's fees and Respondents' request for expungement, are denied.
